**What are the Festival hours?**

Friday – Saturday: 11am-10pm, Sunday: 12 noon-6pm

**What is the price of admission?**

\$5.00, Children 12 and under admitted free, and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

**Directions to Festival Drive-Thru?**

Traveling west (from Freedom Park) on East Boulevard, turn left on Lennox Avenue. Right on East Worthington Avenue and right on Winthrop Avenue. Traveling east (from South Blvd) on East Boulevard, turn right on Lennox Ave. Right on East Worthington Avenue and right on Winthrop Avenue.

**Any helpful information on getting there and parking?**

CATS/Bus/Lynx Light Rail – The Festival is less than a mile walk from the East/West Boulevard Lynx station.

In partnership with INLIVIAN Housing Redefined (formerly The Charlotte Housing Authority) at 400 East Boulevard, Yiasou Greek Festival patrons and volunteers may park free after 5:00 PM Friday, all day Saturday and Sunday. Take advantage of the “2-blocks stroll” to the Yiasou Greek Festival!

Side street parking is available on nearby Dilworth neighboring streets, adhere to posted parking guidelines. Please do not block any driveways.

***Please do not leave your trash in any yards or businesses.***

**Do you offer group discounts?**

School groups and senior citizen groups can make arrangements for free admission by calling the Cathedral office at (704) 334-4771 between 10:00 am and 5:00 pm weekdays at least one week before Festival start.
